



Orion honored with prestigious Manufacturer of the Year Award

Award recognizes company for demonstrating a commitment to business excellence

MANITOWOC, Wis. — Feb. 27, 2009 — Orion Energy Systems Inc. (Nasdaq: OESX) was awarded on Thursday the prestigious Wisconsin Manufacturer of the Year Award at its 21st annual black-tie awards ceremony in Milwaukee, Wis.

Orion won in the medium category for companies with 50 to 299 employees. Orion employs approximately 280 employees. The category drew 21 nominees.
